- 1. We have reviewed the unaudited financial results of Info Edge (India) Limited (the "Company") for the quarter ended September 30, 2016 which are included in the accompanying Statement of Standalone Unaudited Results for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2016 and the statement of assets and liabilities on that date together with the notes thereon (the "Statement"). The Statement has been prepared by the Company pursuant to Regulation 33 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (the "Listing Regulations, 2015") and SEBI Circular dated July 5, 2016, which has been initialled by us for identification purposes. The Statement is the responsibility of the Company's management and has been approved by the Board of Directors. Further, the Management is also responsible to ensure that the accounting policies used in preparation of this Statement are consistent with those used in the preparation of the Company's opening unaudited Balance Sheet as at April 1, 2015 prepared in accordance with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 (Ind AS) prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 and other recognised accounting practices and policies. Our responsibility is to issue a report on the Statement based on our review.
- 2. We conducted our review in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagement (SRE) 2410, "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity" issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This Standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the Statement is free of material misstatement.
- 3. A review is limited primarily to inquiries of company personnel and analytical procedures applied to financial data and thus provides less assurance than an audit. We have not performed an audit and accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.
- 4. Based on our review conducted as above, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the Statement has not been prepared in all material respects in accordance with Ind AS and other recognised accounting practices and policies, and has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations, 2015 and SEBI circular dated July 5, 2016, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.
- 5. We draw attention to the following matters:
 - a. Note 2 to the Statement which states that the Company has adopted Ind AS for the financial year commencing from April 1, 2016, and accordingly, the Statement has been prepared by the Company's Management in compliance with Ind AS.
 - b. We were neither engaged to review, nor have we reviewed the comparative figures including the reconciliation to the Total Comprehensive Income for the quarter ended on September 30, 2015 and accordingly, we do not express any conclusion on the results in the Statement for the quarter ended September 30, 2015. As set out in note 7 to the Statement, these figures have been furnished by the Management.

Our conclusion is not qualified in respect of these matters.

- 2. This statement has been prepared in accordance with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 (Ind AS) prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 and other recognised accounting practices and policies to the extent applicable. Beginning April 1, 2016, the Company has for the first time adopted Ind AS with a transition date of April 1, 2015.
- 3. During the quarter ended September 30, 2016, the Company has issued 200,000 equity shares of ₹ 10/- each fully paid up at ₹ 100/- per share to the Info Edge Employees Stock Option Plan Trust on September 26, 2016 which have been listed in the respective Stock Exchanges on October 13, 2016, ranking pari passu with the existing equity shares of the Company.
- 4. The Board of Directors in its Meeting held on October 27, 2016, has declared an interim dividend of ₹ 1.5 per equity share.
- 5. The management has assessed that based on certain tax rulings, the Employee stock option scheme compensation (ESOP) expenses can be claimed basis the gain in the hands of the employees as opposed to the ESOP expenses debited to the Profit & Loss (based on difference between the fair value at the date of grant and the exercise price) at the time of exercising the options by the employees and accordingly has reversed the provision for income tax amounting to Rs. 403.31 for prior periods.
- 6. The format for un-audited quarterly results as prescribed in SEBI's Circular CIR/CFD/CMD/15/2015 dated November 30, 2015 has been modified to comply with requirements of SEBI's circular dated July 5, 2016, Ind AS and Schedule III (Division II) to the Companies Act, 2013 applicable to companies that are required to comply with Ind AS. The inapplicable items in the format of the above results have not been disclosed.
- 7. The Ind AS compliant corresponding figures in the previous periods have not been subjected to limited review or audit. However, the management has exercised necessary due diligence to ensure that the financial results provide a true & fair view of its affairs.
- 8. Other income for the current period is net of loss recorded on change in fair value of compund financial instruments amounting to Rs. 229.47 Mn.
- 9. This statement does not include Ind AS compliant statement of results and statement of assets & liabilities for the previous year as the same is not mandatory as per SEBI's circular dated July 05, 2016.
- 10. The reconciliation of the net profit reported in accordance with Indian GAAP to total comprehensive income in accordance with Ind AS is given in Annexure-1
- 11. During the year ended March 31, 2015 , the Company had issued 10,135,135 equity shares of ₹ 10/- each fully paid up at ₹ 740/- per share (including securities premium of ₹ 730/- per share) to qualified institutional buyers on September 12, 2014 pursuant to Qualified Institutional Placement (QIP) document, dated September 10th, 2014, as per provisions of section 42 of Companies Act, 2013 read with rule 14 of the Companies (Prospectus and Allotment of Securities) Rules 2014, and Chapter VIII of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2009 which have been listed in the respective Stock Exchanges on September 16, 2014.

Expenses incurred in relation to QIP amounting to ₹ 155.65 Mn had been adjusted from Securities Premium Account during the year ended March 31, 2015. The utilisation out of such net amount of ₹ 7,344.35 Mn till March 31, 2016 is given below. The balance amount of QIP proceeds remains invested in Mutual Funds (Debt) & Term Deposits with banks.
